The Rotary Club of Pangbourne is once again offering Charity Dragon Boat Racing  
at the Pangbourne Summer Fete in conjunction with Henley Dragons Dragon Boat Club*

- Your crew will consist of 17 - 20 people. In each race, led by their drummer beating out the rhythm for paddling, 16 people paddle a dragon boat (a large decorative canoe) along a course of about 250 metres, racing against other teams. Additionally, there is a helmsman who steers. We supply all the equipment, boats, paddles, buoyancy jackets ... and a competent helmsman!
- Location: Beautiful Pangbourne Meadow on the Thames just downstream from the toll bridge. Ideal for picnicking and spectator viewing. Part of Pangbourne Summer Fete.
- Time: Between 09.30 hrs with the finals finishing about 17.00 hrs.
- Knockout competition.
- Every crew is guaranteed three races.
- Dragonhead Prizes and Certificates.
- Crews can raise monies for their own nominated charities or causes through sponsorship.
- A maximum of 18 teams compete on the day.

Team entry donation of £420 covers the minimal costs. Discounted to £395 for early payment (see joining form). All surplus goes to the various charities and causes. The 2007 Challenge raised a net £15,000!
